Intro to World Music

- 🗆 Indian Chordophones
 - ☐ Central to Indian classical music
 - ☐ Typically have a high bridge
 - 🗆 *taraf* sympathetic strings
- □ Raga
 - Complex melodic system of Indian melody that may include...
 - □ a tuning system
 - □ a scale
 - \square a tonic pitch
 - □ "stock" melodic motives
 - a precomposed repertoire
 - \square rules for ornamentation
 - extramusical associations
- □ Tuning
 - | sruti [SHRUH-tee] = microtone
 - 🗖 division of the octave into 12 *sruti*
 - ullet intervals between sruti may be variable depending on raga, instrument, or player
- ☐ Scales (That) [Tot]
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 - "solfege" syllables: sa, re, ga, ma, pa, dha, and ni
 - Komal a lowered tone (the Western flat)
 - Tivra a raised tone (the Western sharp)
 - Shuddh an unaltered tone (the Western natural)
- Arohana/Avarohana meaning "ascending/descending" scale forms
- Extramusical Associations
 - Rasa specific feelings that art can express
 - 🗆 Ragamala collection of paintings symbolically illustrating Indian raga
